Saturday 18 November agreed. Viv to book pool (Booked. Cost £1,114.74)

ACTION VE

Poolside Accreditation

- For all South West Region competitions all coaches team managers and chaperones requiring access
 to poolside must purchase a Poolside Accreditation pass (agreed £5) in advance of the event. They
 must also have a valid DBS check and Safeguarding Certificate. Mary to send Sarah the information on
 Poolside Accreditation.

 ACTION MH
- All Marshalls and Helpers (including non-poolside helpers) must be registered with Swim England and SE numbers provided on the officials list.

Officials for Competitions

Agreed: The number of judges and other officials required from clubs for competitions should be increased as follows:

Judges:

1-5 swimmers = 1 Judge, 6-10 swimmers = 2 Judges, 11+ swimmers = 3 Judges

Swim England Helpers and Marshalls:

All clubs to provide 5 SE helpers

Agreed: If clubs do not have enough volunteers they can approach other clubs for the loan of officials

3. Risk Assessments

All clubs must have a Risk Assessment for each club event, including away events, separate to the main club Risk Assessment. All Regional events must have a separate Risk Assessment for each event.

To note there is a Risk Assessment for Marlborough which can be amended for the Region ACTION MH

Viv to ask Plymouth Life Centre for their Risk Assessment.

ACTION VE

Mary to ask Regional clubs for their Risk Assessments and remind the Regional Squad staff to provide a Risk Assessment for the Regional Squad Assessment Training Day

ACTION MH

Roger will ask the Regional squad to copy any correspondence to Mary.

ACTION RAD

Committee to agree Risk Assessments for all activities, including away events.

Agreed that it would not be financially viable to hold Grade days at Taunton School because they could only offer the school holidays when the number of entries would be low. Mary asked to be informed of the details of any Routine Grade days to be organised by clubs before the event . **ACTION ALL**
