

Minutes from Swim England South West Region Water Polo Technical Committee, held at the Regional Offices, Castle Business Centre, Castle Road, Chelston Business Park, Wellington, TA21 9JQ on Monday, October 14th, 2019

1. Apologies:

- 1.2. Present: Roger Downing, Vice-Chairman of the Regional Board; Stuart Noyce, Swim England South West Water Polo Technical Committee Chairman, Mike Coles, Swim England South West Region President and Secretary of Swim England South West Water Polo Technical Committee Secretary, Simon Tomlinson, Somerset Representative and Head Coach of girls; John Spicer, Gloucestershire Representative and Head Coach of Boys, Martyn Thomas, Specialist; Helen Martin-Hicks, Wiltshire Representative; Brian Steer, Devon Representative; Chris Pryke, Dorset Representative.

2. Approval of Minutes of Meeting of 8th July, 2019

3. Matters Arising from these Minutes

3.1. No matters arising which were not already an agenda item.

4. Notice of items for AOB

4.1. None were forthcoming.

5. Swim England Update

- 5.1. The meeting was informed that all clubs will need to register to Swim Mark in the coming year as Swim England prepare for closer affiliation process.
- 5.2. Clubs are reminded to apply for START Funding. Details had been sent to all Swim England Water Polo Clubs on how to apply and it was recommended that as many apply as possible.

6. Swim England Inter-Region Championships

- 6.1. Under-14s Boys and Girls teams have all been selected and were scheduled to compete on the weekend of 30th November/1st December, 2019 for the Girls; and 7th & 8th December, for the boys. Both events were to be held at Walsall's Gala Baths.
- 6.2. Under-18s Trials were due to be held at the next Regional Training Sessions being held in November, at Millfield. The competition will be held at East Manchester Leisure Centre, Manchester on the weekend of 25th/26th January. The Boys will be held at Ponds Forge Leisure Centre on the weekend of 2nd/3rd February.

7. Swim England South West Region Inter-County Championships 2019

- 7.1. The schedule of play was put together by Stuart Noyce with the information provided on entries. Detailed order of play to be circulated latter in the month.
- 7.2. Trophies & Medals were being sorted by Stuart and Mike Coles, both of whom were liaising with Sue Dors, the Trophy Controller. All trophies had been returned to the regional office, except the John Spicer Trophy, which was still in Cheltenham, but efforts were being made to get it returned and engraved in time for the event.
- 7.3. Stuart Noyce was preparing a list of roles, and Mike Coles was organising the officials for the event.

8. Vacant Positions Update

- 8.1. Comms Officer: Still looking for a volunteer, so Stuart Noyce and Mike Coles would manage until new person found. Post meeting a volunteer has been found.
- 8.2. Boys Academy Administration: A volunteer had been found and was now taking up the post.
- 8.3. Girls Academy Administration: Again, a willing volunteer had been found and was now taking up the post.

9. Regional Academy Update

- 9.1. John Spicer reported that numbers were down on the boys and girls. There was no one coming from Dorset or Cornwall, and only a few from Wiltshire. The bulk came from Gloucestershire and Devon, and a few from Somerset.
- 9.2. Simon Tomlinson reiterated this point and they needed to do a big push for girls to come along to the sessions.
- 9.3. The meeting was reminded that participants needed to pay for year on line and this appeared to be working.
- 9.4. Remining dates for 2019/2010 were as follows:

11. Training Courses

- 11.1. Present Training Courses were a Level 2 Coaches Course scheduled for later in the month at Plymouth.
- 11.2. Table Officials/Referees' Course at Millfield in November
 - 11.2.1. Mike Coles updated to meeting on progress, and because training had not yet taken place, then this course could not proceed.

12. County Officers Reports

12.1. Cornwall: Anthony Stevenson reported that not a lot has changed.

Water polo is played by Penzance, St Austell and Newquay. We have very few matches, but training sessions are well attended. I cannot see this position being any different for many years unless other swimming clubs in Cornwall set up mini / junior sections to play

the game, however I see little evidence that this will happen.

We are entering 5 teams in the Inter County tournament at Millfield, and hope to have full squads for each.

Our main source of experience is to play out of the county for teams in the Bristol and West league, Young St Austell players make up a large part of the very good Devonport under 16 team.

- 12.2. Devon: Brian Steer reported that the Devon League was finished including the new Under 13 league and the Knock Out finals would be held in early December. Teams had been selected for the forthcoming inter-county event or trials were being held.
- 12.3. Dorset: Chris Pryke reported The Lyme Splash water polo tournament hosted at Lyme Regis (3rd/ 4th August) continues to grow from strength to strength, with a total of 18 teams having taken part. It is estimated some 300 water polo players and spectators attended the event, in its 3rd year, with teams from as far away as Newquay, Southampton & Aberdare taking part.

A total of 16 candidates successfully completed the level 1 coaching course hosted at Weymouth/ Portland, delivered by Martin Thomas in June. As a result, Dan Kinsey is due to attend the forthcoming L2 course at Plymouth.

A total of 5 teams from Dorset are due to compete in the forthcoming Regional Inter Counties tournament at Millfield in November.

We await developments to be formalised regarding the proposed Grade D referee course we successfully applied to host last year.

Dan Kinsey (Weymouth & Portland) has won the South West Region Personal Achievement of the year award.

- 12.4. Gloucestershire: John Spicer reported that not a lot was happening on the county front, other than selection of the teams for the forthcoming inter-counties.
- 12.5. Somerset: Simon Tomlinson reported that the senior men had held their county tournament at Millfield, were Frome narrowly beat Weston-super-Mare, by 1 goal, with Taunton finishing in third place. Brad Poole had selected the team members for Somerset Senior team for the inter-county event. Simon went on to say why he would not be entering any other teams in the event, as only Taunton, at present, had any players in the younger age groups.
- 12.6. Wiltshire: Helen Martin-Hicks explained the problems encountered within Wiltshire, with not a lot of co-operation between the other clubs in the county. Salisbury, Marlborough and Swindon participated in the trials, but no one came from the fourth club, Bradford on Avon.

13. Reports from the following Officers:

- 13.1. The changes in allowances was discussed. This has been changed, and allowances will be based on internet usage by the various members of the committee. Details will be published in the New Year.
- 13.2. Development Officer: Mike Coles spoke on future developments for officials training and how the South West was being used as a guinea pig to test run a new day long course being presented by the top officials in the region, who would be trained up by Swim England to present the newly written course locally. Dorset was promised the first course.

14.1. No correspondence had been received as regards to the region.

15. Items to communicate and protocol for social media.

- 15.1. It was pointed out that the region had already written the protocols for social media and that we should follow this protocol.
