

South West Short Course Winter Championships

The Region is minded that whilst Covid-19 social distancing measures are currently relaxed, it could well be that these circumstances may change by November and we will still need to meet capacity limits at the venue.

The Region plans to run an event which mirrors those of previous years, with the main purpose to provide swimmers with the opportunity to qualify for the Swim England National Winter Meet. With this in mind, our schedule and qualifying times for this year takes into account venue capacity as well as age groups for the Swim England National Winter Meet and can be found later in this document.

For the 2021 event, in view of the challenges posed by the pandemic, the Region will allow times to have been achieved in Level 1,2,3,4 and Level X competitions since the 1st September 2019 in line with the Swim England National Winter Meet. This means that conversion times are permitted, using HyTek time converter only.

The 2021 event has a Level 2 license, and as such, the slowest entries may be rejected if the event proves to be over-subscribed in line with event time limits and venue capacity.

The event will commence on Friday evening with the distance events; 800m for female athletes and 1500m for male athletes in line with the Swim England National Winter Meet.

The 2021 event will not contain any relay events.

Awards will be presented to the top three swimmers in each event and the top three juniors in each event. The junior age group will be 15 years and below (Age at 31st December), so incorporates athletes born in 2006 and younger.

Due to venue capacity, the Region will not be allowing spectators at the event and will explore the option of live streaming although cannot guarantee this will be available.

Entry fees will be £8.50 per event.

We will be asking all clubs to support the event with officials and volunteers. Once entries have been confirmed a list of volunteer jobs will be circulated to competing clubs.

Level 2 Licensed Meet

(Under swim England Laws and Regulations and FINA Technical Rules)

Promoters Conditions

These conditions are in addition to SESW Region Competition General and Swimming Conditions.

1. The meet will be held under Swim England Laws and Regulations and Swim England Technical Rules of Racing.
2. All athletes must be registered as category 2 members of their governing body.
3. This competition is only open to swimmers who are registered with a club affiliated to Swim England South West Ltd.
4. Entries will be administered by a third party appointed by the Region and will be held on a computer solely for the purposes of this competition and consent, as required by the Data Protection Act 2018, to the holding of personal information on computer will be deemed to have been given by the submission of the entry. Personal data will be available for inspection during the meet on application to the promoters.
5. Age groups are based on ages at 31st December 2021.
6. A competitor may compete under the name of one club only.
7. Applications for entry must be correctly submitted by the specified date, 19th October 2021. Late entries or additions will not be accepted.
8. Clubs will be invoiced for entry fees once entries have been accepted.
9. The promoter will limit the number of entries should the event be oversubscribed; the slowest entries in each of the relevant events and levels will be scratched. There will be no refunds on accepted entries. Entries must show on the rankings database but may have been achieved in Level 1, 2, 3, 4 or Level X events.
10. Age groups are open and junior. The junior age group is 15 years and below (Age at 31st December), so incorporates athletes born in 2006 and younger.
11. There will be A and B finals of all events, apart from 400m Freestyle, 400m Individual Medley, 800m Freestyle and 1500m Freestyle which will be HDW.
12. We will accept the fastest 32 entries in the 400m Freestyle, 400m IM, 800m Freestyle and 1500m Freestyle with at least 25% of entries being junior swimmers. Entries for these events must still be made with a time in the entry file to be accepted.
13. A secondary strobe will be available at this meet.
14. The heats will be seeded on entry times. All entry times must appear on the rankings database within the qualifying window of the 1st September 2019 to the 17th October 2021.
15. Swimmers must meet the minimum qualifying standard, shown in the qualifying times table, to enter this competition.
16. Competitors must report to the marshals at least 3 heats before their own event. Failure to do so may mean exclusion from their event.
17. All starts will be from the Scoreboard end of the pool. All starts will be over the top, except for backstroke races.
18. Entries will not be accepted without the request of a coaches pass. Coaches will be responsible for their swimmers at all times. Please complete the Coach Pass

Application Form containing Club, Coach Name, Membership number and current DBS number and return to swimsouthwest@swimming.org by 19th October 2021. These are the only people who will be allowed to accompany the swimmers inside the venue.

19. Warm up times may change after entries have been accepted. Warm up procedures will be listed and shared prior to the start of the meet.
20. Clubs are requested to supply a qualified official for every 10 swimmers entered in the competition. However, entries will not be refused from clubs who are unable to supply the recommended number of qualified officials.
21. The promoter reserves the right to refuse admission to any competitor or coach who displays or has previously displayed rude, aggressive or abusive behaviour.
22. The meet promoter will make every effort to run the event. In any situation that the meet must be cancelled competitors are not automatically eligible to a full refund of their entry fees. Proportionate refunds may be made but only after the promoter has covered all incurred costs. In any situation that the meet must be run at either unlicensed or at a lower license level, competitors are not eligible for refunds of their entry fees.
23. Anyone wishing to use a device capable of photography or videoing must take careful note of the information posters. The full Swim England Guidance on Photography can be found in Wavepower the Child Safeguarding Policy and Procedures available at <http://www.swimming.org/swimengland/wavepower-child-safeguarding-for-clubs/>
24. Start lists and results sheets will appear on the regional website and Meet Mobile.
25. Anything not covered in the above conditions and associated literatures will be at the discretion of the promoter but in agreement with the lead referee. The meet organisers will amend the rules where necessary following the advice of the lead referee, but only in the event of a situation out of our control and to ensure the smooth running of the meet.
26. The referees decision is final, subject to Swim England laws. The electronic timing is provisional and may be overruled by the referee.
27. Swimmers with SE/WPS swimming classification must declare this on their entry form. Swimmers with British Swimming Certificates of permanent disability must present this to the referee before the session of their event. Failure to comply could result in disqualification of the event.
28. There will be no spectators at this meet due to a capacity limit at the venue in response to covid. Whilst restrictions have been relaxed nationally, swimmers and coaches are encouraged to act responsibly at all times. All participants in the meet will be governed by the changing legal status of Covid rules as imposed by the Government at the time.

Please note that the closing date for entries is midnight on Tuesday 19th October 2021. This is to allow swimmers the opportunity to gain additional qualifying times at the various competitions taking place on the weekend of the 16th/17th October. All entries must be submitted electronically. Failure to return entries will result in swimmers being excluded from the programme. The programme of events and warm up times are all provisional and may be subject to change once the entries have been received.

Please note that there are no QTs for the 400m Freestyle, 400m IM, 800m Freestyle and 1500m Freestyle. The Region will accept 4 full heats of entries in each of these events with at least 25% junior entries. Times must still be submitted for these races on the entry file.

All entries must be made from times on the rankings database from Level 1, 2, 3, 4 & Level X events since the 1st September 2019. A maximum of 4 heats will be run in the 800/1500m events. Qualifying times have been calculated in relation to the Swim England National Winter Meet 2021 QTs. The Region reserves the right to reject swimmers with a QT to meet the maximum time allowed by licensing regulations or to meet the venue capacity.

Times must be submitted on the entry file for the 400m Freestyle, 400m IM, 800m Freestyle and 1500m Freestyle events to ensure entries can be processed correctly.

The Region will combine the events with able bodied events and results will be from heat declared winner.

Awards

Awards shall be awarded on multi disability points basis to swimmer in 1st, 2nd and 3rd place.
