- 4.2 Entry times: Suggested entry times for open meets at levels 1 – 3 circulated however LL suggested that L1 times should be reduced as some meets not filled. Noted that meets in Cornwall might find times too restricting. CE to discuss with organisers. Agreed in principle as guidelines but need monitoring.
- 4.3 County competitions have gone well so far.

# 17.5 Minutes of the Events Management Meeting 15/02/17

- 5.1 Disibility Gala at Horfield on 12<sup>th</sup> March all set.
- 5.2 Summer Championships:

**Hengrove**: CT informed SRS will not be allowed to attend. RM to circulate information in advance and print link for online ordering in Hengrove programme. <a href="Catering">Catering</a>: food at Hengrove was diabolical and has not improved at Open meets. Agreed that officials should bring their own and claim £5 if working all day. Tea and coffee will be provided. MB to ensure lap cards are available at Hengrove. **Millfield**: expected that queuing will be excessive for the swim shop due to issue at Hengrove. CT to discuss with staff.

# 17/6 Minutes of the Masters Committee meeting 5/02/17

- 6.1 Meeting attended by Sharon Lock (ASA Masters Swimming Officer) noted problem with communication. Discussion around database.
- 62. Swimmers will need a ranked time to enter Nationals in October. These are currently quite low but will be tightened over time. Need to promote the requirement for QTs for our Masters competition.
- 6.3 Development Day arrangements progressing well. Already have 17 applicants. Sports Psychologist and land training expert attending.
- 6.4 Regional Decathlon winner Simon Veale placed 5<sup>th</sup> nationally. Totnes SC finished 2<sup>nd</sup> in Men's National Team section of Decathlon and Gloucs City Ladies finished 3<sup>rd</sup>.
