Swindon Autumn Level 3 Open Meet - Conditions

(Under Swim England Laws and Regulations and Swim England Technical Rules)

Promoters Conditions

1. The meet will be held Under Swim England Laws and Regulations and Swim England Technical Rules of Racing
2. All competitors must be registered as Club Compete or equivalent with their governing body.
3. Entries may be held on a computer solely for the purposes of this competition and consent, as required by the Data Protection Act 2018, to the holding of personal information on computer will be deemed to have been given by the submission of the entry. Personal Data will be available for inspection during the Meet on application to the Promoters.
4. Age groups are based on ages at **18th October 2026**
5. The Female Category is for birth sex females in accordance with swim England's Transgender and Non-Binary Competition Policy. By entering the Female Category, a swimmer confirms that their birth sex is female.
6. A competitor may compete under the name of one club only.
7. Applications for entry must be correctly submitted by the specified date, **Friday 18th September 2026**, and on Hy-Tek entry file for 5 swimmers or more. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the promoter, but not to the detriment of entries received on time. Entries received without payment will not be processed.
8. Entries are on a 'First Come First Serve Bases'. The promoter will limit the number of entries should the events be over-subscribed, the slowest entries in each age group will be rejected until the programme is full. Strictly no refunds on entries without a doctor's certificate. Entries do not need to show on the rankings database.
9. 400m Free Events are for 10yrs+, 400m Medley Events are for 11+ and will be a maximum of 4 heats per event.
10. **Any swimmer who, at the closing date of entries for the Meet including those entered early, that has achieved a time faster than the published upper limit may not enter that event or will be entered by the host club as a time trial swim if time permits once all swimmers under the uppers limit have been accepted. Should it transpire at any stage that a swimmer has submitted an ineligible entry or not declared a faster time, then the entry will be rejected, and the fee forfeited. It is the Clubs responsibility to be transparent with any times improved above the QT standard at close of entry.**
11. Spectators will be allowed but by minimal numbers.
12. Age groups/events; 9/10, 11/12, 13/14, 15/16 17&OV. All events will be heat declared.
13. Medals will be awarded to the top three swimmers in each of the above age groups in the able-bodied category & to the top 3 overall Para/Disabled swimmers based on British Disability Points. If there is only one Para/disabled entry in an event the swimmer must match or better the entry time to be awarded the gold medal.
14. A Secondary Strobe will be available at this meet. This must be requested on entry.
15. The heats will be seeded on entry times. All swimmers must have achieved times within the entry criteria as set out in the upper limit Qualifying Time below. NO TIME entries will not be accepted. Coaches are asked to enter all swimmers with either a ranked time, Time Trial time or club estimated time.
16. Competitors must report to the marshals, one event before their own event. Failure to do so may mean exclusion from the event.
17. All starts will be at the deep end of the pool. All starts will be over the top, except backstroke races.
18. The entries will not be accepted without the purchase of a Coaches pass. All Teams must be accompanied by at least one Swim England Coach or the equivalent Level 2 Coach who must have current Safeguarding and DBS passes. Team Managers on poolside must be TM1 Qualified and be DBS Checked.
19. Warm up times are as listed in program details. Diving is only permitted in sprint lanes. Warm up procedures will be listed prior to the start of the meet.
20. Clubs are requested to supply a qualified Official for every 8 swimmers entered into the competition.
21. The promoter reserves the right to refuse admission to any competitor or spectator who displays or has previously displayed rude, aggressive, or abusive behaviour.
22. The Meet Promoter will make every effort to run the event. In any situation that the meet must be cancelled, competitors are not eligible for full refunds of their entry fees. Proportionate refunds may be made but only after the promoter has covered all incurred costs. In any situation that the meet must be run at either unlicensed or at a lower licence level, competitors are not eligible for refunds of their entry fees.
23. Anyone wishing to use a device capable of photography or video recording must take careful note of the information posters. The full SE Guidance on Photography can be found in Wavepower the Child Safeguarding Policy and Procedures available at <http://www.swimming.org/swimengland/wavepower-child-safeguarding-for-clubs/>
24. **The use of any device with video or photo capture capability are strictly prohibited in the toilets, changing rooms or changing area's at any time. Strict Sanctions will be imposed if this rule is broken.**
25. Result sheets will be forwarded via email and will appear on the Swindon website following each completed event.

26. Disability Swimmer entries – The competition shall be run as an integrated competition. Para-Swim/Disability competitors must have an authorized disability Classification, or Certificate of Disability/Exemption which must be declared on the entry form and presented to the Referee before the start of each relevant session before racing commences. Failure to do so may result in disqualification. Entries should be made on the Hy-Tek file and also be accompanied with a Para Application Form.
27. Anything not covered in the above rules and associated literature will be at the discretion of the promoter but in agreement with the Lead Referee. The Swindon Open meet organisers will amend the rules where necessary following the advice of the Lead Referee, but only in the event of a situation out of our control and to ensure the meet runs smoothly.
28. The Referee's decision is final, subject to SE Law. The electronic timing is provisional and may be overruled by the referee.

Closing date for entries is midnight on Friday 18th September 2026. Failure to return entries will result in swimmers being excluded from the event. Programme of events Warm up times are provisional & may be subject to change once the entries have been received. Swimmers will be notified accordingly.
