The Region plans to run an event which mirrors those of previous years, with the main purpose to provide swimmers with the opportunity to qualify for the Swim England National Winter Meet. Accordingly, the schedule and consideration times for this year takes into account venue capacity as well as age groups for the Swim England National Winter Meet and can be found later in this document.

For the 2026 event the Region will allow short course times to have been achieved in Level 1 2 and 3 competitions since the 3rd November 2025. Conversion times will be permitted, using Sportsystems time converter only. <https://www2.sportsys.co.uk/time.asp>

The event will commence on Friday with a distance event and other events.

Due to venue capacity, the Region will be allowing limited spectators at the event and will explore the option of live streaming although cannot guarantee this will be available. A ticketing system will be implemented, and entry will be via tickets only.

Entry fees will be £12.00 per event.

We will be asking all clubs to support the event with officials and volunteers. Once entries have been confirmed a list of volunteer jobs will be circulated to competing clubs.

Awards will be 1st 2nd 3rd place in the Senior (16 +) and Junior (15 U) Final.

South West Short Course Winter Championships Level 2 Licensed Meet

(Under Swim England Laws and Regulations and Swim England Technical Rules)

Promoters Conditions

These conditions are in addition to SESW Region Competition General and Swimming Conditions.

1. The meet will be held under Swim England Laws and Regulations and Swim England Technical Rules of Racing.
2. All athletes must be registered as Club Compete members of their governing body.
3. This competition is only open to swimmers who are registered with a club affiliated to Swim England South West Ltd and who have not swum in any other regional area events over the last calendar year.
4. The Promoter of the event will be SE South West Regional Swimming Committee
5. Entries may be administered by a third party appointed by the Region and will be held on a computer solely for the purposes of this competition and consent, as required by the Data Protection Act 2018, to the holding of personal information on computer will be deemed to have been given by the submission of the entry. Personal data will be available for inspection during the meet on application to the promoters.
6. Age groups are based on ages at 31st December 2026.
7. A competitor may compete under the name of one club only.
8. The Female category is for birth sex females in accordance with Swim England's Transgender and Non-Binary Competition Policy. By entering the 'Female' category, a swimmer confirms that their birth sex is female.

9. Applications for entry must be correctly submitted by the specified date, 19th October 2026. Late entries or additions will not be accepted.
10. Clubs will be invoiced for entry fees once entries have been accepted.
11. The promoter will limit the number of entries should the event be oversubscribed; the slowest entries in each of the relevant events and levels will be scratched. There will be no refunds on accepted entries. Entries must show on the rankings database but may have been achieved in Level 1, 2 or 3 events.
12. Age groups are 13/14, 15, 16 and 17 plus
13. There will be Senior and Junior finals of all events, apart from 400m Freestyle, 400m Individual Medley, 800m Freestyle and 1500m Freestyle which will be HDW.
14. We will accept at least the fastest x number of entries in for all events, number is listed on in the Consideration Times. Entries for these events must still be made with a time in the entry file to be accepted. Para Swimmers are not included in this number they will be in addition to.
15. If entries are low in one event the promoters of this event may wish to fill other events with more than the number required to allow more athletes to swim
16. If any deletions are necessary from any event these will be made across all age groups not, simply the slowest entries.
17. There will be a secondary sign in process for the 800m Freestyle and 1500m Freestyle events. Swimmers must sign in prior to the warm up session starting. Coaches may sign in on behalf of the swimmer.
18. A secondary strobe will be available at this meet.
19. The heats will be seeded on entry times. All entry times must appear on the rankings database within the qualifying window of the 3rd November 2025 to the 19th October 2026
20. Swimmers must meet the minimum Short Course consideration standard, shown in the consideration times table, to enter this competition. Long Course conversion times are applicable if they meet the minimum time shown in the consideration table. using Sportsystems time converter only.

21. Competitors must report to the marshals at least 3 heats before their own event. Failure to do so may mean exclusion from their event.
22. All starts will be from the Scoreboard end of the pool. All starts will be over the top, except for backstroke races.
23. Coaches and team managers will be responsible for their swimmers at all times. The Coach/Team Manager Pass will need to be applied for through the online Swim England Accreditation process. All Teams must be accompanied by at least one Swim England Coach or the equivalent Level 2 Coach who must have current Safeguarding and DBS passes. Team Managers on poolside must be TM1 Qualified and be DBS Checked. Full details on how to do this are on the final page of this information pack.
24. Warm up times may change after entries have been accepted. Warm up procedures will be listed and shared prior to the start of the meet.
25. No swimming aids i.e. flippers, snorkels, hand paddles etc. will be allowed in the warm up / swim down pool.
26. Clubs are requested to supply qualified officials and volunteers to assist with the running of the event.
27. The promoter reserves the right to refuse admission to any competitor, coach or spectator who displays or has previously displayed rude, aggressive, or abusive behaviour.
28. The meet promoter will make every effort to run the event. In any situation that the meet must be cancelled competitors are not automatically eligible for a full refund of their entry fees. Proportionate refunds may be made but only after the promoter has covered all incurred costs, should any situation arise that causes the meet to be cancelled, be run at either unlicensed or at a lower license level, competitors are not eligible for refunds of their entry fees.
29. **The use of any device with video or photo capture capability is strictly prohibited in the toilets, changing rooms or changing area's at any time. Strict sanctions will be imposed if this rule is broken.**
30. Anyone wishing to use a device capable of photography or videoing must take careful note of the information posters. The full Swim England Guidance on Photography can be found in Wavepower the Child Safeguarding Policy and Procedures available at

31. Psych sheets will be available on the website. Heat sheets will be supplied to Coach and Team Manager via WhatsApp and printed– **maximum of 2 per club will be printed.**
32. Anything not covered in the above conditions and associated literature will be at the discretion of the promoter but in agreement with the Technical Director. The meet organisers will amend the rules where necessary following the advice of the Technical Director, but only in the event of a situation out of our control and to ensure the smooth running of the meet.

33. The referee's decision is final, subject to Swim England laws. The electronic timing is provisional and may be overruled by the referee.
34. The Competition will be run as an integrated competition. Para-Swim/Disability competitors must have an authorised disability Classification, or Certificate of Disability/Exception which must be declared on the entry form and be presented to the Referee at the start of the relevant session before racing commences. Failure to do so may result in disqualification.
35. Officials who officiate at any of the Sessions will be entitled to Reimbursement of Expenses according to the South West Region's Officials Expenses document. This can be found on the SWR Website - www.swimwest.org.uk/swimming and can also be requested from the Referee on the day. Officials should request the Expenses Application Form from the Lead Referee which should be completed and returned to that Referee during the duration of the Meet. This condition applies to all qualified Licensed Officials including those Officials who have swimmers competing in the meet but does not apply to trainee officials.
36. There will be spectators at this meet but due to a capacity limit at the venue a ticketing system will be implemented. Online ticket sales will be available nearer the event. Entry will only be allowed with a valid ticket purchased prior to the event.

Please note that the closing date for entries is midday on Monday 19th October 2026. This is to allow swimmers the opportunity to gain additional qualifying times at the various competitions taking place on the weekend of the 17th/18th October. All entries must be submitted electronically. Failure to return entries will result in swimmers being excluded from the programme. The programme of events and warm-up times are all provisional and may be subject to change once the entries have been received.

Eligibility

All swimmers must have an authorized SE/IPC swimming classification or a Certificate of Disability / Exception. Qualifying standards will apply, and all swimmers can qualify from Level 1, 2 or 3 events and must have been achieved in the qualification window specified.

Heats

The Region will combine the events with able bodied events and results will be from heat declared winner.

Awards

Awards shall be awarded on multi disability points basis to swimmer in 1st, 2nd and 3rd place. Medals will be given to the top 3 Para/Disabled swimmers based on British Disability Points. If there is only one entry in an event the swimmer must match or better the entry time to be awarded the gold medal.

Coach/Team Manager Accreditation Process

For this event we will be using a new system for Coaches and Team Managers to apply for their poolside passes. We will be using the Swim England System for Accreditation which will make the process much easier for clubs and the Region when processing.

This is the same system that is used for many national events and involves applying through the website and printing out your pass that you will take along to the event.

1. Log into www.swimmingresults.org
2. On the 'Members' tab click on 'Swim England Member Options'. This will bring up a log in screen which you will need your membership number and password for (details on how to make an account or reset your password if forgotten is available on this page).
3. Once you are logged in you should have a number of options listed. Click on the link for 'Purchase accreditation for events here'. Please note you must ensure that you have a headshot uploaded and that all your qualifications, Safeguarding and DBS information is in date on your clubs OMS system.
4. After clicking the link the page will show a number of events from around the Country, you will need to scroll to find 'South West SC Winter Championships'.
5. All of the fields for this event will need to show as pass in a green box for you to be able to purchase accreditation. If any of the boxes are red you will need to go back to your club and make sure that all of the information is up to date.
6. Once on this page there is a link for 'purchase accreditation' click on that and follow the prompts.
7. After payment it will give you the option to print your accreditation, please print this and bring along to the event. We will be handing out lanyards and pouches at the event for you to add this to. Without the pass you will not be admitted to the event.
