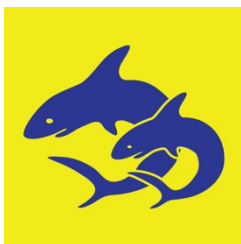

Tigersharks Level 3 Open Meet - Conditions

(Under Swim England Laws and Regulations and Swim England Technical Rules)

Promoters Conditions

1. The meet will be held Under Swim England Laws and Regulations and Swim England Technical Rules of Racing
2. All competitors must be registered as category 2 with their governing body.
3. Entries may be held on a computer solely for the purposes of this competition and consent, as required by the Data Protection Act 2018, to the holding of personal information on computer will be deemed to have been given by the submission of the entry. Personal Data will be available for inspection during the Meet on application to the Promoters.
4. Age groups are based on ages at **30 June 2024**
5. The Female Category is for birth sex females in accordance with swim England's Transgender and Non-Binary Competition Policy. By entering the Female Category, a swimmer confirms that their birth sex is female.
6. A competitor may compete under the name of one club only.
7. This is a first come first serve meet. Applications for entry must be correctly submitted by the specified date, Saturday **8th June 2024**, and on HyTek entry file for 5 swimmers or more. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the promoter, but not to the detriment of entries received on time. Entries received without payment will not be processed.
8. The promoter will limit the number of entries should the events be oversubscribed; From the last accepted club, the slowest entries in each age group will be rejected until the programmed time fits. Strictly no refunds on accepted entries without a doctor's certificate. Entries do not need to show on the rankings database.
9. Spectators will be allowed but by minimal numbers.
10. Age groups/events; 10/U, 11/12, 13/14, 15/16 17&OV. All events will be heat declared.
11. A Secondary Strobe will be available at this meet
12. The heats will be seeded on entry times. All swimmers must have achieved times within the entry criteria as below.
13. There are upper limit qualifying times for this competition. Please see table details below
14. Competitors must report to the marshals, one event before their own event. Failure to do so may mean exclusion from the event.
15. All starts will be at the deep end of the pool. All starts will be over the top, except backstroke races.
16. The entries will not be accepted without the purchase of a Coaches pass. COACHES are responsible for their swimmers at all times.
17. Warm up times. As listed in program details. Diving is only permitted in sprint lanes. Warm up procedures will be listed prior to the start of the meet.
18. Clubs are requested to supply a qualified Official for every 10 swimmers entered into the competition. However, Tigersharks will not refuse entries from clubs who are unable to supply qualified Official's.
19. The promoter reserves the right to refuse admission to any competitor or spectator who displays or has previously displayed rude, aggressive, or abusive behaviour.
20. The Meet Promoter will make every effort to run the event. In any situation that the meet must be cancelled competitors are not eligible for full refunds of their entry fees. Proportionate refunds may be made but only after the promoter has covered all incurred costs. In any situation that the meet must be run at either unlicensed or at a lower licence level, competitors are not eligible for refunds of their entry fees.
21. Anyone wishing to use a device capable of photography or video recording must take careful note of the information posters. 22. Result sheets will be forwarded via email and will appear on the Tigersharks ASC website following each completed event.
23. Disability Swimmer entries - All swimmers must have an authorized SE/IPC swimming classification, Certificate of Disability of Function Ability Card. In addition, details of disability must be provided with entry. Please ensure you present, Certificate of Disability or Function Ability Card to the Referee prior to each competition session, failure to do so may result in disqualification
24. Anything not covered in the above rules and associated literature will be at the discretion of the promoter but in agreement with the Lead Referee. The Tigersharks Open meet organisers will amend the rules where necessary following the advice of the Lead Referee, but only in the event of a situation out of our control and to ensure the meet runs smoothly.
25. The Referee's decision is final, subject to SE Law. The electronic timing is provisional and may be overruled by the referee.

Closing date for entries is midnight on Saturday 8 June 2024. Failure to return entries will result in swimmers being excluded from the event. Programme of events Warm up times are provisional & may be subject to change once the entries have been received. Swimmers will be notified accordingly.

 - 3c. Winner of round 4 wins £20.
4. Stroke will be picked out of a hat each round.
5. Juniors will start first, Seniors 1 minute 30 after.
6. Round one a full race start.
7. Remaining rounds 10 second warning and then just starting signal.

We will offer an allowance for each travelling qualified official and in addition the officials will be given a full lunch.

Expenses policy:

- Expenses - we are following the SwimWest expenses policy with one or two minor changes, which is reproduced below:
- Mileage will be checked and verification may be requested before payment is made. Payment for mileage will be made at £0.45/mile and will normally be between home address and the venue. If the journey starting point differs from the home address payment will be made for whichever is the shorter distance. Where an official has a competing swimmer at boarding school and travels from outside the region, mileage will only be paid from swimmer's home club/school. Mileage between the pool and the hotel will be limited to 5 miles.
- Accommodation
 - Applicable to any event with consecutive days. Maximum claim 1 night per weekend or 2 nights if work 3 days. Officials must work all sessions over both or all days, Journey must be in excess of 1 hour.
 - Claims for accommodation on the night prior to competition (e.g. Friday night) are allowed if the journey is in excess of 75 miles or 1.5 hours in time and the official works two full days.
 - Accommodation to be shared where possible. Accommodation costs will be considered for those who make an official request on the Officials form, **and approved in advance**. Officials will need to book their own accommodation and make a claim for reimbursement on the Expenses Form and include the receipt for both hotel and evening meal.
 - Presently the maximum allowance is £80 for 2 officials sharing a double/twin room or £60 single including breakfast and car parking charges. Accommodation costs above this amount will not be refunded except with prior approval.
 - Evening Meal:
 - This is normally paid for those who have approval for overnight accommodation. A detailed receipt **MUST** be attached to the claim form. If the receipt is for multiple people it must be clear which items are for the official. Current rate is a maximum of £17.50 per night (alcohol cannot be included).
- NB. Those who fulfil club duties requested by the Events Management Secretary are not entitled to claim expenses. J1 trainee Officials will be provided with lunch and may claim expenses.
- Expenses will be reimbursed in full where the official has no swimmer in attendance and will be paid at 50% where the official is accompanying a swimmer
